



POSITION: Part-Time Computerized Numerical Controls (CNC) Instructor

LOCATION: Swainsboro Campus

POSITION DESCRIPTION: The responsibilities for this position will include advising and registering students for classes, teaching coursework and maintaining paperwork for the CNC program. Courses to be taught will include: Machine Tool Math; Blueprint for Machine Tool; CNC Fundamentals; CNC Mill Manual Programming; CNC Lathe Manual Programming; CNC Practical Applications. This position will not exceed 29 hours/week. Flexible hours may include night classes..

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

An Associate degree or Technical College diploma in Computerized Numerical Controls is required, as well as three years of work experience in the field. Successful candidates will be required to pass a criminal background record check.

SALARY/BENEFITS: Salary is commensurate on education and work experience. This is a part-time position and is therefore not eligible for health or flexible benefits.
