POSITION DESCRIPTION:

The responsibilities for this position will include advising and registering students for classes, teaching coursework and maintaining paperwork for the CNC program. State standard courses to be taught will include Machine Tool Math; Blueprint for Machine Tool; CNC Fundamentals; CNC Mill Manual Programming; CNC Lathe Manual Programming; CNC Practical Applications. Flexible hours may include night classes and some weekends.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS (Educational/Occupational Experience):

Three years of work experience in the field. Successful candidates will have multiple certifications in the field and required to pass a criminal background record check.

PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS

A Technical College diploma in Computerized Numerical Controls (CNC) is preferred.
