Student Responsibilities

- **Show up!**

 - Follow directions for completing all assignments!
 - Comply to all deadlines! EX: For online assignments, midnight deadline means access is denied at midnight. You better be finished by 11:59. If you are completing an assignment and the deadline approaches, it will disappear! This includes online quizzes/tests!

Speaking of deadlines:

- Avoid having it rejected and having to redo it – make sure your name and SS number match your SS Card
- If you are taking Summer Classes, go ahead and do two and you'll have one done for Summer Semester, too – See me soon about Summer semester classes
- All paperwork and a copy of your SS Card due by Jan. 8th – which is first day of classes.
