CTD students receive commercial truck driving training on site and on the road in day or night classes over a seven-to-ten week period.

Entrance Requirements:

- Be at least 18 years of age
- Have a valid Georgia Driver's License
- Provide a 7-year Motor Vehicle Report that shows no more than 8 points or 3 moving violations in the last 3 years and no DUI in last 7 years
- Pass a D.O.T. physical*
- Pass NIDA 5 drug screening*

(*Not required until all other criteria has been met.)
