

CAREERSCOPE

Offers a broad range of career assessment measures. The assessment includes a twelve-scale interest inventory and a seven-part aptitude battery that yields measures of General Learning Ability, Verbal Aptitude, Numerical Aptitude, Spatial Aptitude, Form Perception and Clerical Perception. Motor ability scores estimates (motor coordination, finer dexterity, and manual dexterity) can also be accessed.

GAfutures

(Provides a skills assessment, school and occupational information, and job outlook for Georgia)

1. Go to <http://www.gafutures.org>
2. Click on **Create An Account** (If you have a current GAFutures profile, you can use those account credentials to sign in)
3. Click on **Career Exploration**
4. Click on **Learn About Yourself**
5. Complete one or multiple assessments
6. Print out your results
7. You may also view information about occupations and schools in this program.

Occupation Outlook Handbook

(The Occupational Outlook Handbook gives you job search tips, links to information about the job market in each State, and much more. It tells you: the training and education needed, earnings, expected job prospects, what workers do on the job, working conditions)

1. Go to <http://www.bls.gov/oco/>
2. Enter a *Job Title* in the **SEARCH** box and click **GO**
3. Click the Printer Friendly icon to print out an occupational summary of the position

O*Net Online

(The Occupation Information Net is the nation's primary source of occupational information)
