East Georgia State College and Southeastern Technical College Transfer Articulation Agreement

This Agreement formally recognizes the common goal of East Georgia State College (EGSC) and Southeastern Technical College (SETC) to increase the number of college graduates in Georgia in support of the Complete College Georgia Plan. This partnership implements a transition plan for currently enrolled and potential students of both institutions to minimize loss of credits and course duplications upon transfer of credits between STC and EGSC. Central to the success of this partnership is the creation and promotion of educational pathways for students.

Purpose of the Agreement

The Agreement promotes the following strategies:

- Assist prospective transfer students at SETC with the seamless transfer of the common core courses to EGSC;
- Provide SETC students who successfully complete the courses as listed herein and are otherwise eligible for admission, to be admitted to EGSC;
- Assures SETC students who are admitted to EGSC that the courses specified in this Agreement will transfer to EGSC; and
- Provide a reverse transfer option that enables EGSC students that transfer to SETC to re-enroll at EGSC with minimal loss of credits and course duplications upon transfer.

Cooperation

Both parties agree to extend their best efforts to ensure that the transition from the SACSCOC accredited SETC to EGSC will be as seamless as possible for the student. Both parties enter into this articulation as cooperating, equal partners with the responsibility to maintain the integrity of their separate programs, to remain true to their institutional missions and to maintain the spirit of this Agreement.

Coordinated Communication

SETC and EGSC agree to cooperate in communicating with each other concerning the Agreement. Communications may include common publications and announcements concerning their affiliation. Announcements of this articulation and of changes in the relationship will have a coordinated release to the public from both institutions. The institutions will inform and educate its faculty, staff, and specifically its academic advisors, about implementation of the Agreement. The institutions will encourage dissemination of information about programs in this agreement to interested and qualified students, with both institutions providing advising and counseling to prospective students.

Accreditation

This Agreement is made contingent on both parties maintaining all applicable program and institution accreditations, including both SACSCOC and appropriate professional bodies, and in the event of loss of accreditation by either institution the other institution may terminate the Agreement upon written notice.

Articulated Courses

The parties restate their commitment to the seamless transfer of the "mini core" courses between accredited USG and TCSG institutions, per prior articulation agreement. See *East Georgia State College —Southeastern Technical College Equivalents* chart, attached. A SETC student who successfully completes any of the courses detailed herein, is in good standing at SETC, and meets the appropriate admission requirements to EGSC will be assured that the courses listed in this Agreement earned at SETC will transfer to EGSC. A minimum grade of "C" or above will be required for all Area A courses (ENGL 1101, ENGL 1102, MATH 1101, MATH 1111).

A student may not transfer more than 60% (40 credit hours) of the credit required for an associate or baccalaureate degree. Both institutions are committed to advising students accordingly so that credit earned is applied appropriately toward the degree. SETC acknowledges that the attached articulated courses are eligible for transfer of credits to EGSC; this Agreement does not apply to other institutions in the University System of Georgia.

Reverse Transfer

To ensure that SETC and EGSC students can seamlessly transfer credits to and from SETC and EGSC, both parties agree to accept the articulated courses listed herein as equivalent courses for their respective institution, and to award course credit accordingly. Students that move between SETC and EGSC may do so without loss of credit or duplication of courses, thus incentivizing students to complete a course of study and obtain a college degree.

Regular Review

At least one administrative or faculty member will be appointed from each participating institution to act as the primary point of contact and agent for this agreement, to speak for the institution and to communicate detail and modifications to respective faculty, advisors and others with interest at the individual institutions. Both institutions are committed to regular and open communication regarding enrollment, articulation and program change.

In the event that either institution elects or is required to amend the East Georgia State College-Southeastern Technical College Course Equivalents chart, each party agrees to make every effort to accommodate the needs of the other party

such that the articulation can be preserved.

This Agreement will be in effect for one year. Regular review of this Agreement will occur at least annually from the date of this Agreement. Both institutions agree to provide whatever data is need by the other institution to support the Complete College Georgia initiative and to support accreditation requirements.

This Agreement is subject to the policies and procedures of the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia, the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges, East Georgia State College and Southeastern Technical College.

The authorized representatives of each party signify their acceptance and approval of the terms of this Transfer Articulation Agreement by signing where indicated.
