

Fall 2026 Book Distribution Information

1) Complete Orientation Part A

New students must complete DUAL ENROLLMENT Orientation Part A. Visit the **STC Homepage** and follow these steps: **Admissions** → **New Student Orientation** → **Dual Enrollment Orientation Part A**.

2) Bring Student ID

Students without a college student ID will have one created – required for books and proctored exams. Parking decals will be issued to students taking classes on the STC Campus.

3) Print Semester Schedule

Print class schedule, including semester start and end dates, by going to **MySTC**.

Students will be prompted to **enter a username**, which is a student ID number (9100xxxx).

Click **My STC Experience** → **Registration Tools** → **Print my Schedule** → **Select Current Term** → **Schedule Details** → **Print**. If you have never logged in or do not know your password, click **Help**.

4) Need Help?
