We hope your Summer classes are going well!! We wanted to send information to you for your students regarding our articulation agreement and degree completion programs through Mercer University's Working Adult format. Some of the key highlights of the Working Adult format include:

- · Flexible course offerings:
 - Online: There are no on campus visits required with this format
 - Traditional class meetings on campus at our Atlanta, Douglas County, Eastman, Henry County, Macon and Newnan campuses
 - Hybrid format that includes a combination of online and traditional class meetings
- +2 programs based on an articulation agreement between the Technical College System of Georgia and Mercer University (MU) in which Mercer University agrees to accept into the program students who have completed their associate's degree. Note: only nondevelopmental courses and courses with grades of C or better are eligible for transfer and the articulation agreement does not guarantee acceptance.
- Mercer University accepts transfer credits from Regionally Accredited schools: up to 64 semester hours from 2 year institutions and 96 semester hours from 4 year institutions.
- Students are eligible for the Hope Scholarship, the Georgia Equalization Grant, and Federal financial aid including Pell grants and subsidized/unsubsidized loans based on need.
- Students in all programs receive access to in person and online academic resources including library resources, electronic course materials, the Academic Resource Center, and student support services.
- Students receive individualized academic advising by full time Mercer University program faculty.

We hope these programs offer your students the opportunities and flexibility they may need in order to earn their Bachelor's degree. We have included a full copy of the articulation agreement and a program matchup sheet which highlights how an Associate's degree from a Technical College System of Georgia school might match up with a Mercer University Bachelor's degree.
