Please use this checklist to ensure that you submit a COMPLETE scholarship packet. This checklist is for <u>your</u> use and does not need to be submitted with your application. The completed scholarship packet must contain:

u	Application. The application is accessible through the Southeastern Technical College website. The entire form, including the statement of need, must be completed in order to be accepted. The application should be typed.
	Southeastern Technical College acceptance letter or proof of registration (class schedule) for the 2024 Summer and/or 2024 Fall Semester.
	An official high school or most recent college transcript (can be printed from BannerWeb).
	Two letters of recommendation from a non-family member , of which only one can be from an STC or high school faculty/staff person. Each letter should be on letterhead, signed, and address the applicant's character and academic performance and/or community service.

The completed scholarship packet (application, acceptance letter/proof of registration, letters of reference, and transcript) must be received by deadline, **no exceptions.**

Only a **COMPLETE** scholarship packet will be accepted. **Incomplete packets will not be eligible for a scholarship and will not be reviewed by the committee.**
